[Race Review]

#15 Iwasa starting the race from the second grid position left the grid late and moved down to 13th position. On the other hand, #16 Nojiri starting the race from the 7th grid overtook 3 cars and moved up to 4th position. He lost one position then took a pit stop after 10 laps. After going back to the track, he made an undercut over Makino and Oyu.

Though #16 Nojiri continued to run with an attention to Tsuboi who had not taken a pit stop yet, he was overtaken by Oyu at 17th lap and was by Tsuboi at 31st lap after Tsuboi's tire change and went down to 3rd position. He then kept his position and won 3rd place at the podium. #15 Iwasa took a pit stop at 39th lap and ended up the race with 11th place.
